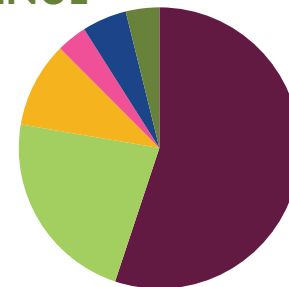
121 Agency Partners.

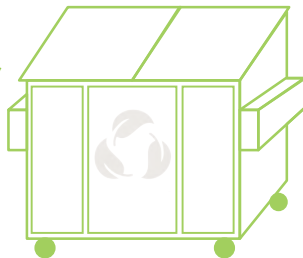

Of this rescued food, **99%** went to feeding our community.

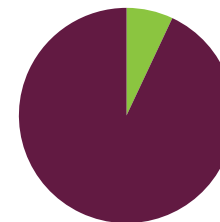


OUR VOLUNTEERS
